



CORONA – NORCO REGION 37 INJURY INSTRUCTIONS

In order to ensure that our children and volunteers are allowed to play and participate in a safe environment, please take the time to review the following guidelines:

- ALL INJURIES (at practice or games) must be reported to Regional Safety Director, on an Incident Report Form.
- An Incident Report Form and Medical Release Form must be attained by the Coach/asst. coach/manager at the Referee Tent on game day or from the Safety Director or online through our web site under forms. ayso37.org
- Please fill out the Incident Report Form with as much information as possible, by the parent or guardian, coach, assistant coach or team manager and returned to the Safety Director. **Please INCLUDE the injured player's home phone number.**
- Please take all injuries serious and do not push the player to participate if they or the parents feel they cannot. Better to be **SAFE** than sorry!
- Any injury in which a player receives medical attention, a Medical Release Form (Region or Physician) **MUST** be completed and **SIGNED** by the physician and returned to the Safety Director prior to being allowed back to practice or games, **WITHOUT** any restrictions, unless approved by the Safety Director and/or Regional Commissioner.
